

#### **Application Criteria and Instructions**

APPLICATION DEADLINE: April 30, 2021 - NO EXCEPTIONS.

#### Scholarship criteria include, but are not limited to the following:

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior, current full time community college or university student in good standing.
- He/She must be a resident within a 50-mile radius of Sacramento.
- Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 overall grade point average (GPA).
- Unofficial transcripts are accepted. If awarded the scholarship, <u>official</u> high school or college transcript(s) are required. Transcripts must be unopened.
- Identify financial need in essay.
- Submit two letters of recommendation:
  - One letter from a college mentor or faculty member; or high school teacher or counselor.
  - One letter from a community person who is familiar with your community engagement activities.
- African-American students are encouraged to apply.
- Applicant must respond to essay prompts. See instructions at the bottom of this page.
- Selected candidates may have a personal interview.
- Please submit personal photo, 3x5 or larger (or electronically using a .jpeg or .png format to sacncbwscholars@gmail.com).
- All scholarship materials, transcripts, and letters should be submitted electronically or by mail.

#### **Essay Instructions**

Please submit a typed essay responding to <u>all</u> of the following prompts. Your essay response should be between 150-250 words **per question**. Your essay score will consider whether you identify financial need.

- 1. How have you demonstrated leadership ability both in and out of school?
- 2. How has the last year and the COVID-19 pandemic impacted your personal or educational experience and explain how it shaped your development?
- 3. Choose a person or persons you admire and explain why?
